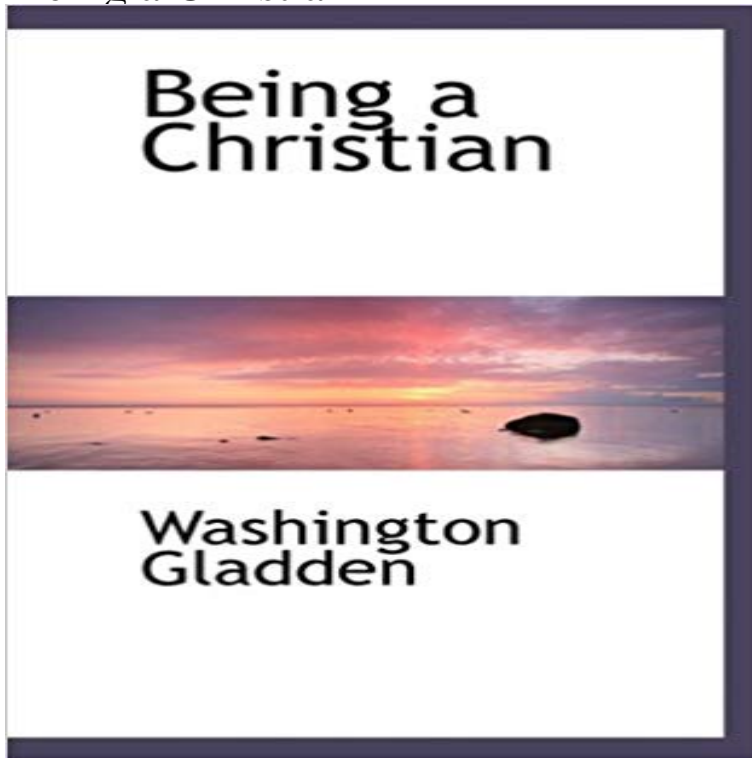


Being a Christian
