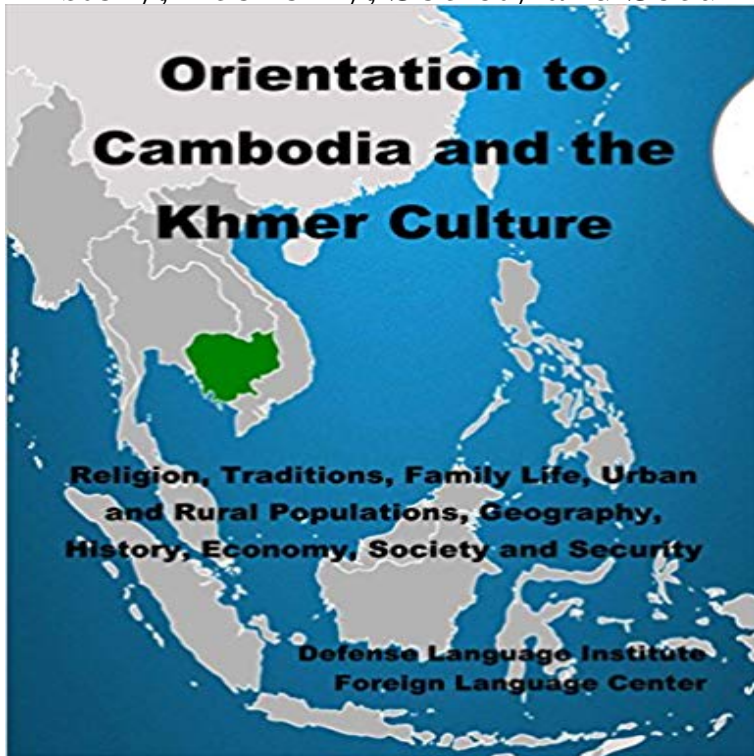

In the modern era, Cambodia is most known for the atrocities suffered under the Khmer Rouge, a brutal regime whose vision of a socialist utopia resulted in the deaths of over one fifth of the nation's population. Three decades after the genocidal Khmer Rouge regime was removed from power, Cambodia now enjoys relative stability under a democratically elected government. However, as subsistence farming employs 75% of the workforce, many Cambodians continue to live in poverty.
