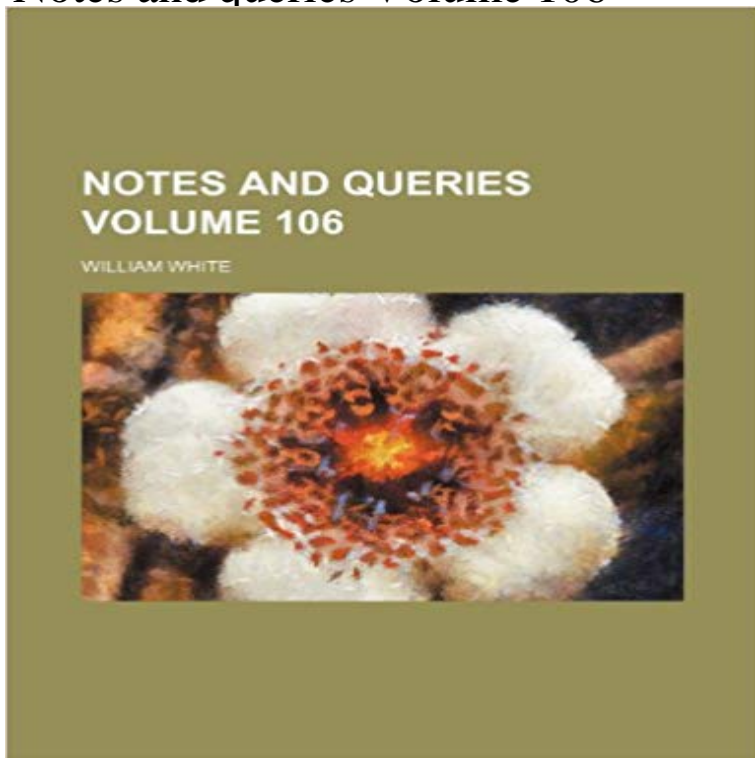

A curious bandying of the slang in vogue in those days is preserved in the matter of a quarrel between these two nobles.
