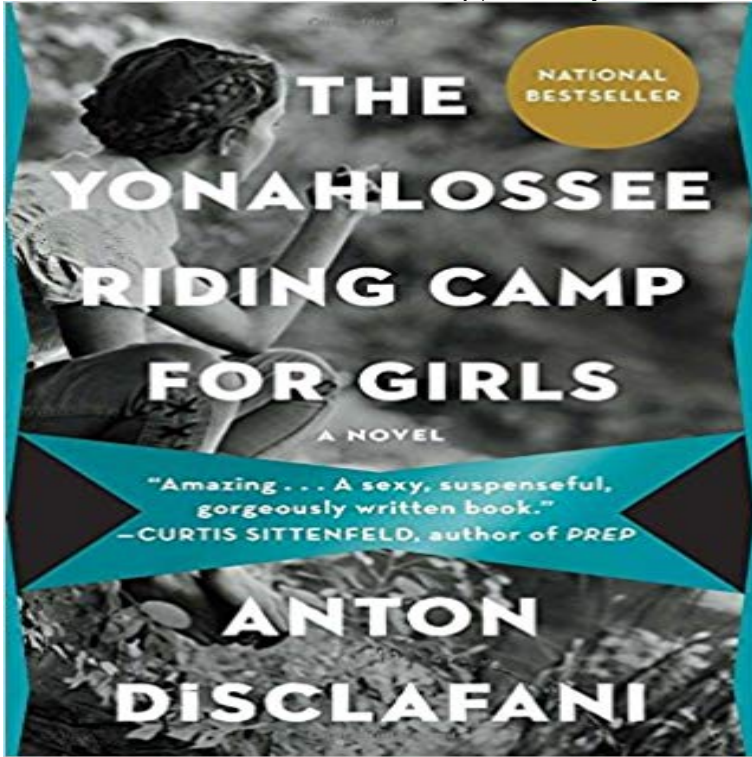


The Yonahlossee Riding Camp for Girls
