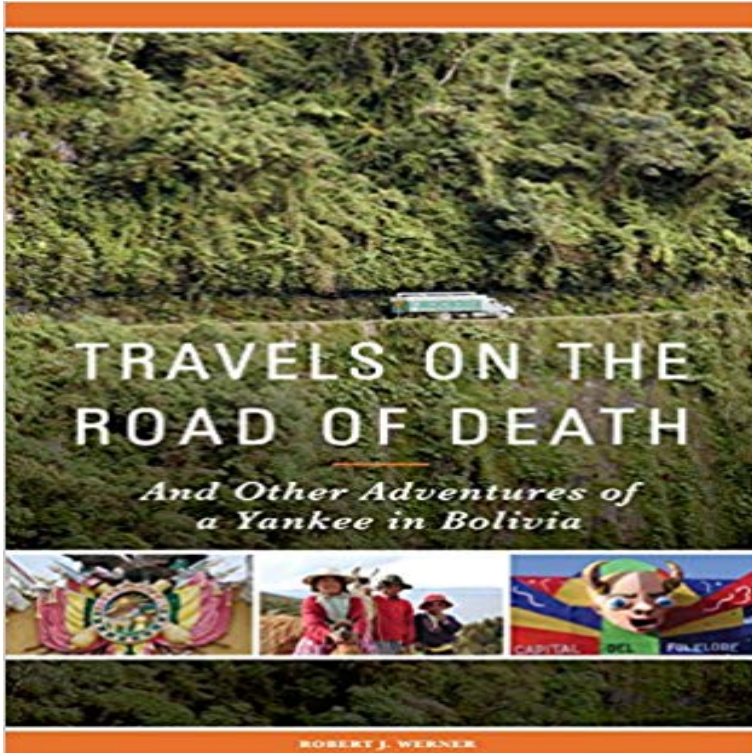


# Travels on the Road of Death and Other Adventures of a Yankee in Bolivia
