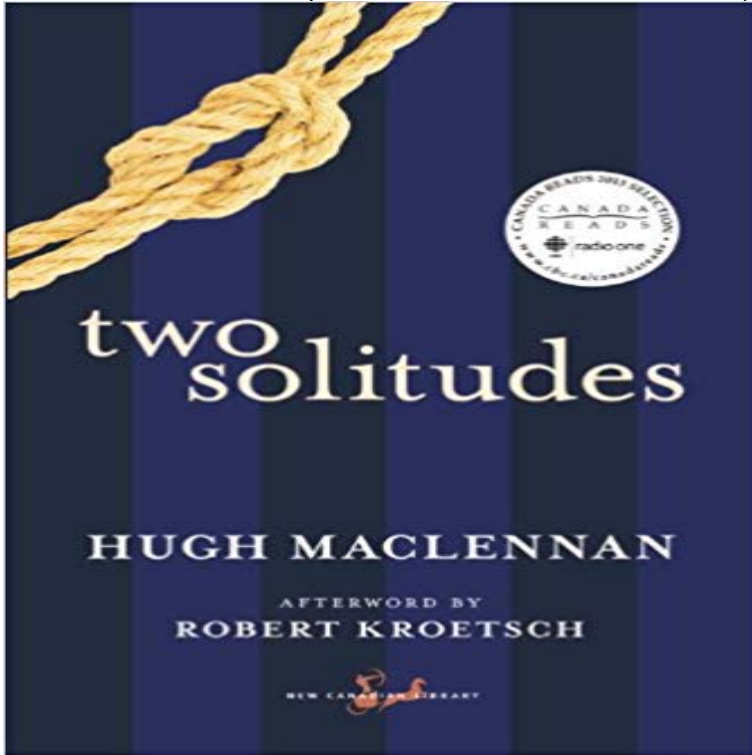


Two Solitudes (New Canadian Library (Paperback))

With these words Hugh MacLennan begins his powerful saga of Athanase Tallard, the son of an aristo-cratic French-Canadian tradition, of Kathleen, his beautiful Irish wife, and of their son Paul, who struggles to establish a balance in himself and in the country he calls home. First published in 1945, and set mostly in the time of the First World War, *Two Solitudes* is a classic novel of individuals working out the latest stage in their embroiled history.
